4. Payment

A non-refundable reservation charge of £60 must accompany this completed booking form. The balance will be required 8 weeks prior to arrival. We will send you a letter or email to remind you when the balance is due. If we do not receive the balance in full and on time, we reserve the right to treat the holiday as cancelled by you, with the reservation charge forfeited. Please note that we can only accept cheques or cash.

If you need to cancel your holiday booking, the person who signed the booking form must notify us immediately. If notification occurs within 8 weeks of arrival we will make every effort to re-let the property in which event we will refund your final balance less costs incurred.

5. Cleaning and Accidental Damage to Property/Contents

A deposit of £100 cash will be required on your arrival at Les Brousses, which will be held against any damage to the property or contents.

Please leave your holiday cottage in the same clean condition as you found it on your arrival, otherwise we will deduct £25 from the deposit to pay for cleaning, which is the amount we pay to clean each cottage.

The French are really hot on recycling and will refuse to collect our rubbish or even fine us if it is not properly sorted out, so please note that we will charge £5 if you do not dispose of all rubbish and recycling - you will find details of where to leave rubbish and recycling in your holiday cottage.

6. General Booking Conditions

We aim to provide you and your family with a pleasant, safe, clean and relaxing environment for your holiday. If you have any concern, please make us aware and we will rectify the situation as soon as possible. Safety is a high priority. However, it remains the responsibility of parents to ensure that children are properly supervised at all times, particularly in the garden and around the poolside area.

Keys may be collected from the main house anytime from 1600 hours on your arrival day. If you intend to arrive late (after 2000 hrs) would you please advise the owners prior to the day of arrival so we can make necessary arrangements to hand over the keys. Please note that accommodation must be vacated by 10.00 am at the latest on the day of departure. Your co-operation with this condition would be greatly appreciated so that we may prepare for incoming guests.

It is a condition of acceptance that the hirer and party have adequate personal and cancellation insurance. It is understood that the personal belongings and baggage are at the hirers risk at all times. The accommodation provided must only be used by the person(s) shown on the booking form and subletting, sharing, or assignment is prohibited. Under no circumstances may the number of people exceed the maximum occupancy stated.
